Preliminary remarks

In this document, the masculine gender is used for the sole purpose of simplifying the text.

The Fête du Lac des Nations Inc (hereinafter referred to as "the organization" or "FLN") wishes to offer an event that is accessible to all, regardless of their limitations. This policy is intended for anyone with a temporary or permanent motor, visual, auditory or cognitive limitation. The Fête du Lac des Nations Inc. also considers financial limitations and wishes that the entire population can participate in its event.

Objectives

The purpose of this policy is to remove physical, social and communication barriers that prevent people from actively participating in the event.

Defenitions and concepts

1. Universal accessibility

Universal accessibility is the character of a product, process, service, information or environment that, in an equitable and inclusive manner, enables any individual to perform activities independently and to achieve equivalent results.

Existing measures

1. Concrete actions

The Fête du Lac des Nations inc. ensures that its event is accessible to all through various measures put in place:

- Measures for people with limited mobility:
- Parking spaces specially reserved for people with limited mobility;
- Adapted shuttles;
- Toilets for people with limited mobility;

Measures for low-income people:

- Donation of 875 daily tickets to the public via the [Corporation de développement communautaire de Sherbrooke](#);
- Free admission for children under 11 years old;
- Accessible rates.

2. Accessibility objectives

2023	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Addition of a Privilege Zone with reserved seats for people with reduced mobility;- Increase by 25 the number of free tickets offered to the Sherbrooke CDC, for a total of 875 tickets;
2024	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Offer a total of 900 tickets to the Sherbrooke CDC ;
2025	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Offer a total of 925 tickets to the Sherbrooke CDC ;
